

## Winter Park Rules

- One person per snow tube unless a ticketed rider is under 42" tall.
- Children under 42" tall may ride on a parent's or guardian's lap while tubing if the child is able to walk on, ride up and walk off of the Magic Carpet on their own or walk up the snow tubing hill. No infants on the hill.
- Standing only on the Magic Carpet. No running, walking or sitting in a tube. Small children may not be held or carried while on the Magic Carpet.
- Tubers under age five must be accompanied by an adult while snow tubing.
- Tubes must remain on the hill.
- No pushing or spinning tubes at the top of the hill.
- No more than four tubes in a group (train).
- Put tow lanyard and ring inside of tube before going down the hill.
- Get up quickly from the bottom of the hill.
- Tubers must be off the track before the next tube can start down the hill.
- Horseplay is prohibited.
- Bad language is not allowed.
- Tickets and tubes will be revoked for violations.
